**Truck Inspections**

- Check batteries (by starting truck)
- Check for abnormal tire wear
- Check tire air level
- Check oil level
- Check radiator fluid level and color
- Check fuel level in truck
- Check lights (blinkers etc.)
- Check water level
- Inspect front end and undercarriage for damage
- Test Siren
- Test light bar and all other emergency lights
- Start truck and let engine run for minimum of 5 minutes
- Check horn operation
- Test radio by stating “Wise County, Brush 225, Radio Check”

**Inside Cab** – Inventory & Inspections

- County map book
- Mapsco map book
- Clipboard with at least 10 run sheets and 2 pens
- Black notepad with pen
- Rechargeable flashlight mounted in charger (test each flashlight)
- (2) – Orange flashlight cones
- Pliers in each door panel
- Fluorescent flag on a stick (behind seat)
- Jumper cables (behind seat)
- Bolt cutters (behind seat)
- Hydrant wrench (behind seat)

**Rear** - Inventory & Inspections

25' tow chain

5 gallon bucket of foam (min. 1/2 full)

(2) - Combination rakes

(2) – round head shovels

Pick head axe

Grey toolbox w/ misc. ball valves

25' – 2.5" Fill line

25' – 1.5" Synthetic fire hose w/ nozzle (check operation)

Pony motor

Run for minimum of 3 minutes

Check fuel in pony motor

Check oil in pony motor

Check air filter in pony motor

Hose reel

Check hose reel motor for operation

Inspect hose and nozzle for damage and operation
